Who is Miss Huntington Beach?

The tradition of Miss Huntington Beach spans over 100 years, with the idea of serving the community and providing a positive role model.

The program provides intelligent, ambitious young women the opportunity to win financial assistance to attain their educational goals.

The Scholarship program is funded by donations received from local businesses, through the Miss Huntington Beach organization, a 501c (4) non profit entity.

The Miss Huntington Beach Scholarship Program is looking for young women who are confident, poised, intelligent, hard working and compassionate. They must possess good communication skills and adept at making others feel welcome in their company.

Miss Huntington Beach should be active within the community and willing to make public appearances one or more times per month at civic and business events. She must maintain the level of dignity and decorum that the position implies.

Sponsor dollars go towards education expenses (tuition, books, and supplies) for the college of their choice. Miss Huntington Beach must have educational goals and a community platform in which she is involved.

The competition is open for women between 18-25 years of age who either lives, works or attends school in Huntington Beach.

1. Rules for Miss Huntington Beach

Must be a high school senior or college student between 18 to 25 years as of October 4, 2014. Need not be enrolled full-time. Must live, or work or attend school in Huntington Beach and show proof of such for 6 months prior to date of application.

Personal Status: A contestant cannot be or ever have been married, nor cannot be pregnant or have previously given birth.

Public appearances for Miss H.B. and her Court are to be approved in writing in advance by the Miss Huntington Beach organization, and include special instructions for each event.



**2. Preliminary Selection – Saturday, September 20, 2014
1:00 to 3:00 p.m.
Huntington Beach Civic Center**

Each candidate for Miss Huntington Beach must attend the Preliminary Judging to be considered for one of (up to) eleven finalists to compete for Miss Huntington Pageant Scholarship Awards.

Contestants should dress in business attire and be prepared to tell the judges about their self and why they want to be Miss Huntington Beach.

Contestants will be notified by September 22 as to their eligibility to compete in the Scholarship Pageant on October 4, 2014. Finalist selections will be made by The Miss Huntington Beach organization.



**3. Scoring Criteria
Final Judging Oct. 4, 2014
(Each category represents 25% of your overall score)**

- Interview: Contestants will wear business attire appropriate for a job interview. Each contestant will be interviewed by the panel of judges in a private nonpublic area for approximately 5 minutes.
- Business wear competition: Contestants will begin the public program in business attire and be introduced to the audience beginning at 1:00 p.m. Each contestant will have 2 minutes to talk about their self. A typical statement would include name, age, high school or college, major, interests, activities and goals.
- Athletic wear competition: Contestants will wear athletic attire, suitable for exercise activities (i.e. yoga, jogging, volleyball, etc.). Each contestant will be asked to answer a random question from the list of 20 questions about Huntington Beach that will be provided to you at the preliminary selection on September 20.
- Formal wear competition: Evening gown attire and sponsor recognition.



**4. Scholarship Pageant – Saturday, October 4, 2014
1:00 to 3:00 p.m.
Huntington Beach Civic Center**

Finalists will be included on the Miss Huntington Beach website and printed program with a photo and short bio provided by each contestant (due by September 20).

Contestants will arrive by 11:00 a.m. on October 4, to prepare for pageant and receive final instructions from event coordinators.

Enough time will be given for hair, make-up and wardrobe prior to 1:00 p.m. start.



5. Scholarship Awards

Scholarships are paid to Miss Huntington Beach and her Court based on invoices & receipts submitted within one year of October 4, 2014, and may not include funds for expenses prior to 10/4/14.

A maximum of a one-year extension may be granted upon written request sent by registered mail and postmarked prior to October 4, 2015 for unused scholarship funds.

A contestant who begins use of her scholarship is required to show activity in her scholarship endeavors. If there is a nine-month period with no activity, the balance of that award will be forfeited, and transferred to general funds for other future candidates' awards, unless a one year extension has been approved by the Miss Huntington Beach organization.

Scholarships in excess of \$600 per calendar year are treated as a cash disbursement with a Form 1099 issued to both contestant and IRS. It is your responsibility to claim your expenditures as an education deduction.

Eligible contestants will be provided a form to submit requests for payment – to be paid directly to an educational entity or as a direct reimbursement to the contestant.
